



Valley-Wide Recreation & Park District is an independent special district created to provide park and recreation services for an area that now includes more than 275,000 residents. Our boundaries encompass an 800-square-mile area, which includes the cities Hemet, Menifee and San Jacinto and the unincorporated communities of Aguanga, French Valley, Winchester Temecula and Valle Vista. In the early 1970s, a group of San Jacinto Valley residents teamed up to promote a Park District to offer recreational opportunities for youths, adults and seniors. The District was approved by voters and authorized on July 27, 1972. Since its creation, the District has grown from one park to 83 parks and facilities, many of which have received national and state recognition for their design, innovation and style, as well as youth and adult sports leagues and hundreds of educational and recreational classes and programs. Our parks attracts an estimated 4 million visitors per year.

dispose of them properly. In addition, smoking and alcohol are not allowed in the parks at anytime. During special events, dogs are not allowed in the parks, and during regular operating hours, dogs must be on a leash, and accompanied by the owner at all times.

GENERAL DISTRICT INFORMATION

INSURANCE INFORMATION:

Valley-Wide Recreation and Park District is unable to assume responsibility for injuries or accidents occurring on grounds while participating in programs or activities. Such insurance would make program fees prohibitive.

DISCOUNT FOR DISTRICT RESIDENTS:

An additional per program fee will be charged to each participant living outside the District boundaries.

JUMPERS/BOUNCE HOUSE:

All jumpers and bounce houses must be pre-approved by Valley-Wide Recreation and Park District.

REFUNDS & CANCELLATIONS:

25% of fee or \$25.00, whichever is less, will be charged on all refunds. There will be no refunds after final registration dates or after the program is in progress. Programs are subject to change without notice.
