Valley-Wide Recreation and Park District is in the process of replacing the playground equipment at two parks to enhance the enjoyment of our visitors.

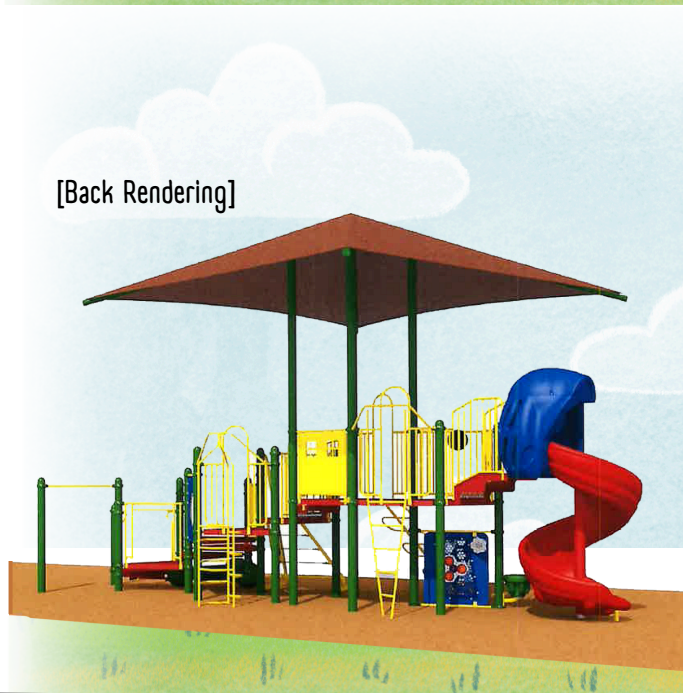

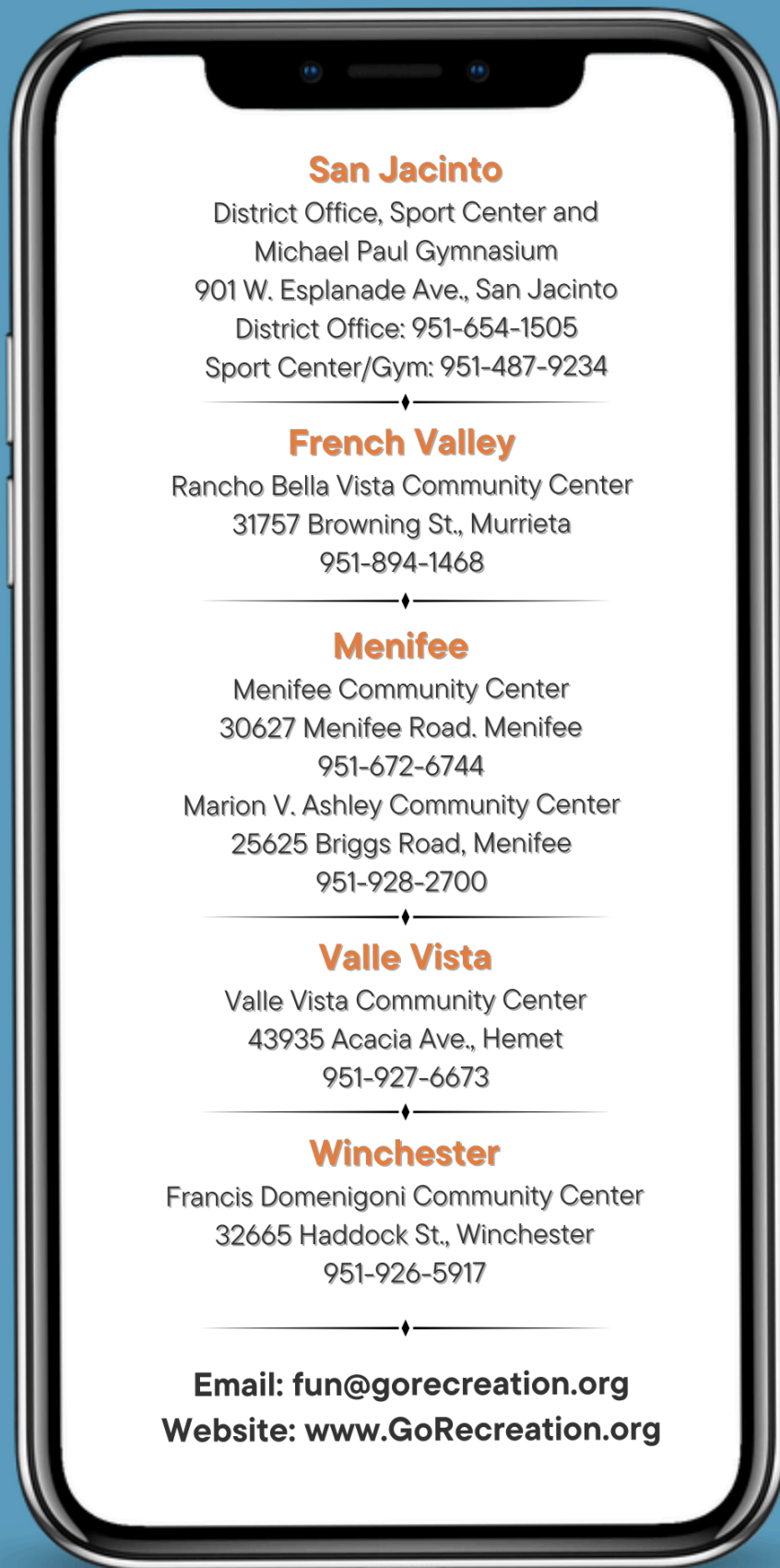
