


### Jack Warneke

Valley-Wide Recreation and Park District is an independent special district created to provide park and recreation services for an area that now includes more than 275,000 residents. Our boundaries

encompass an 800-squaremile area, which includes cities of Hemet. the Menifee and San Jacinto unincorporated the communities of Aguanga, French Valley, Winchester, Temecula, and Valle Vista. In the early 1970s, a group of San Jacinto Valley residents teamed up to promote a Park District to offer recreational

opportunities for youths, adults and seniors. The District was approved by voters and authorized on July 27, 1972. Since its creation, the

District has grown from one park to 87 parks and facilities, many of which have received national and state recognition for their design, innovation and style, as well as youth and adult sports leagues

not allowed in the parks at anytime. During special events, dogs are not allowed in the parks, and during regular operating hours, dogs must be on a leash, and accompanied by the owner at all times.

Anyone who arrives at Echo Hills Golf Course immediately sees a sign that proclaims it as the "Friendliest Golf Course in the San Jacinto Valley". Ed Dover created the nine-hole, 26acre course on the site of what was once a chicken ranch. He converted an old chicken shed into the clubhouse that's still in use today. Echo Hills opened in 1959 and shut down in 2010 due to high water costs. Valley-Wide Recreation took over the course two years later and following a rehabilitation, it reopened in 2013.

A 2,229-yard, par 35 course, Echo Hills is geared toward beginners and senior golfers looking for a round that isn't overly challenging. Although the course is considered easy to walk, cart rentals are available. Tee times must be arranged over the phone. Classes are held at various times throughout the year in conjunction with "Grandfathers for Golf", an organization that attracts youth to the game and teaches under privileged children and others how to play.




